At Bear Spirit Medicine Lodge, Pipe Ceremony is a meaningful community prayer experience open for participation of all people. It is held the each month and is conducted in keeping with the traditional ways of the Blackfoot people.

The pipe ceremony is a sacred ritual for connecting spiritual and physical worlds. Pipe ritual may be conducted inside or outside.

The pipe is our prayers in physical form. Smoke becomes our words; it goes out, touches everything, and becomes a part of All-That-Is.

Tobacco is used because its medicine is to connect All-That-Is.
